



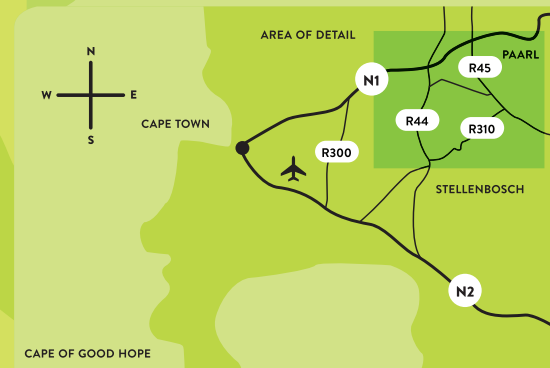

The Simonsberg mountains are at the centre of the Cape Winelands, approximately 45km from Cape Town, South Africa. These prominent mountains rise nearly 1400 metres above sea level and form a stark boundary between the wine growing regions of Stellenbosch (to the southwest), Paarl (to the north-east) and Franschhoek (to the east).

**SOME FACTS ABOUT THE SIMONSBERG**

- Wine has been grown on the Simonsberg since the 17th century.
- Leopards, lynx, boks, and dassies live on the mountain.
- The complete loop around the Simonsberg is 44 km long.
- There are 285 different wines to taste on the loop!
